HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS COLLEGE

Secondary Training College is a Government teacher – training college founded in 1906 in Mumbai. Secondary Training College is University Constituent of Dr. Homi Bhabha State University Founded by Act VI, by the legislative Assembly in February 2019. Ours is the first ever (Government Owned) Cluster University format in Maharashtra State and Country. The college is situated strategically at Dhobi Talao, Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus Area Mumbai, Maharashtra 400001.

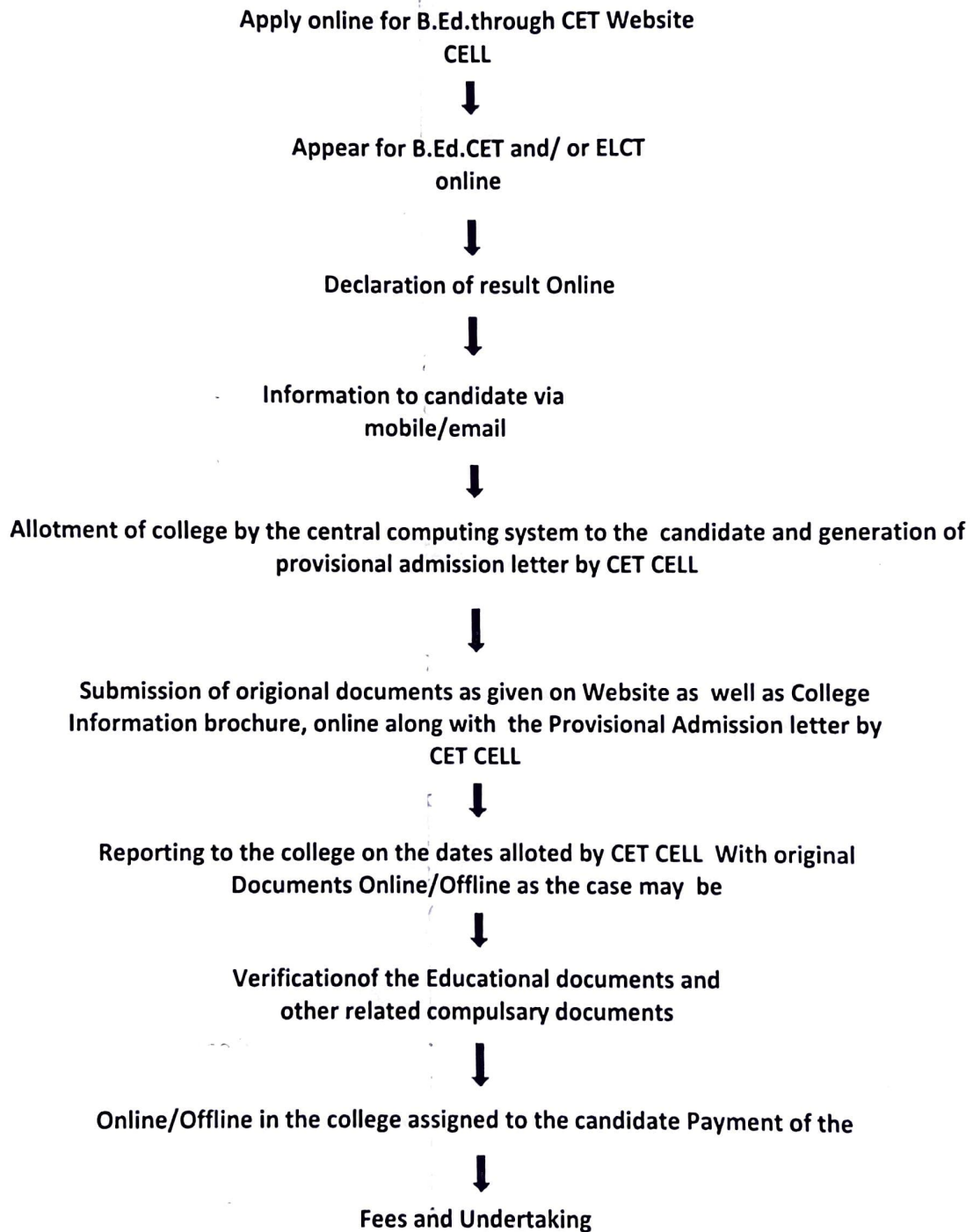
The college is easily accessible by train service on either side (i.e Central Railway and Western Railway). It is very well connected via bus. The college has a well equipped Library with Rare Books Section All the books are available in English, Hindi, Urdu and Marathi Languages. Modern Computer Laboratory with internet facility is available for the students in the college. College runs a full time, two year undergraduate Teacher Education Programme recognized by the NCTE (2015), which prepares. Teachers for the Secondary and Higher Secondary level.

The eligibility for the B.Ed programme is graduation or Post graduation from any discipline with a minimum of 50% Marks. Admission procedure is Centralised and is conducted by the CET, cell and ARA, Maharashtra and monitored by DHE, Pune, Maharashtra. Residential government Hostel facility is also available for boys and girls. Fees is charged according to the Prevailing Government Rules, and as prescribed by commisions CET cell Mumbai. All relevant free ships and Scholarships are given to the students.

The Secondary Training College underwent NAAC accreditation and was accredited with an (A) grade and a Score of (3.23) in the year 2015 by NAAC committee for the Second time. Secondary Training College has a teaching staff that is highly experienced and competent.
